Minutes -

Motion was made by Gabrielle, South Medford to approve the Minutes from the February 25th meeting and the Meet 1 meeting, Korey, Rogue River seconded the motion.

No discussion.

Vote: 11 Yes, 0 No, 0 Abstain. Motion passed.

Discussions were held regarding parking during the Meet, no dogs allowed near arenas or stalls, only in camping and must be on a leash.

Eligibility - because of spring break and school closure, Ashland was unable to get their eligibility report. Therefore, the District took a vote to let them participate in the Meet, with the caveat that if any athlete is reported ineligible, all points for that athlete will be forfeited, including any Team events that athlete participated in. Ashland agreed and also committed to have an answer from the school by Tuesday, April 2nd so final results could be tabulated.

Motion was made by Anna Kruse, Hidden Valley and seconded by Gabrielle, South Medford to approve.

Ashland also asked when Meet 3 eligibility had to be turned in. Sam replied that before anyone can ride, and the eligibility for Meet 3 carries over to State competition.

Sam informed coaches that Posse members from Klamath were there to volunteer and therefore had gate jobs taken care of but would need back up timers for Gaming events. Deena asked if judges were doing official timing or announcer. Sam would ask and get back to her.

There will be Athlete games at 5:30pm, Easter themed. There will be prizes. Taylor Gorden, Youth rep organized some very fun games.

Discussion was had about the ballots for Sportsmanship and Coach of year, where bins would be and when votes are due. Votes are due by end of Meet 3. If you didn't put in at Meet 1, you can still do so.
